Effective Pain Management (EPM)

This program includes up-to-date, best practice and evidence-informed palliative care knowledge, utilizing the innovative Partnering for Palliative Education learning environment, powered by D2L Brightspace.

Over six weeks, local palliative nurse consultant coaches work with EPM learners to provide foundational knowledge and skills in pain assessment, management and evaluation from a palliative care approach. The focus of the course is on the pharmacological management of pain which can them be applied to practice.
