Online Classroom

What is an Online Classroom Session?

An online classroom session is **NOT a webinar.** A webinar is a one-way lecture, which provides information to a large audience, with limited interaction among learners

An **online classroom** session is a collaborative web conferencing tool with online whiteboards, breakout rooms, and screen sharing capabilities for conducting highly-interactive, live, online teaching sessions. Learners are expected to actively participate in the learning, through peer & facilitator discussions and face-to-face online interactions.

We use Zoom as our online platform.

Connecting to the Online Classroom

The online classroom will open 10 minutes before the start of class to give you time to get logged in and work out any technical issues you may have as well as to allow our facilitators to begin the class on time.

To Connect to the online classroom, please follow these steps:

- Log into the PFPE platform using your username and password.
- Close the pop-up Welcome Page (if applicable)
